

Keynote Speaker: Renée Brassard



Renée Brassard is an Assistant Professor in the School of Social Work at Université Laval, as well as a researcher at the International Center for Comparative Criminology of Université de Montréal and at The Interdisciplinary Research Center on Family Violence and Violence against Women (CRI-VIFF). Dr. Brassard is specialized in the field of the criminal justice and the Natives in Quebec, more specifically, on the prison trajectories of the native men in Quebec and programs of native spirituality within Quebec's prisons. Between 2010-2014, she has leaded a large-scale study on the domestic violence to the native women in Quebec. She leads actually a study on the experience of domestic violence of the native men in Quebec and a study on Inuits and Cree justice profile in Nunavik and James Bay region.
